CG [Certified Genealogist] and CGL [Certified Genealogical Lecturer] are service marks of the Board for Certification of Genealogists<sup>®</sup>, used under license by associates who meet genealogical competency standards prescribed for its particular programs. AG [Accredited Genealogist] identifies genealogists who meet competency standards of the International Commission for the Accreditation of Professional Genealogists. FASG designates Fellows of the American Society of Genealogists, the field's scholarly honorary society, limited to fifty Fellows elected for life on the basis of their published genealogical scholarship.
